CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS on July 16, 2020, Justyn Bell, Acting Director, in his designated capacity as chief inspector under the *Mines Act*, having found that Mountainside Quarries Group Inc. contravened sections 1.11.1 and 1.11.2 of the *Health, Safety and Reclamation Code for Mines in British Columbia*, imposed an administrative penalty ("**AMP**") pursuant to section 36.2 of the *Mines Act* (the "**Decision**");

AND WHEREAS Mountainside Quarries Group Inc. appeals the Decision to the Environmental Appeal Board under section 36.7 of the *Mines Act*;

AND WHEREAS the parties have agreed to resolve the entirety of this appeal by fixing the AMP amount at CA \$38,475.00 payable within 5 months;

NOW THEREFORE the Environmental Appeal Board orders under section 16 of the *Administrative Tribunals Act*, S.B.C. 2004, c. 45, in full resolution of Mountainside Quarries Group Inc.'s appeal in this matter, and by consent of the parties, that the AMP amount is fixed at CA \$38,475.00;

AND there shall be no costs payable by any party;

AND the appellant, Mountainside Quarries Group Inc., shall pay the AMP amount fixed at CA \$38,475.00 to the Minister of Finance within 5 months of the date of this order;

AND this Order may be signed in counterparts.
