THE BOARD ORDERS under Section 17 of the *Administrative Tribunals Act*, S.B.C. 2004, c. 45 that:

- 1. The appeal assigned EAB File No. EAB-WIL-22-A002 is dismissed on the following terms of the settlement:
 - a. Pursuant to Section 40.1 of the *Wildlife Act,* R.S.B.C. 1996, c. 488, the Respondent will amend the Appellant's licence WL21-622943 so that it will be valid until June 30, 2026 but otherwise will be subject to the same terms and conditions as currently issued.
 - b. The Appellant will remit to the Ministry of Forests the amount of \$160.00 representing the amount remaining on a five-year licence fee.
- 2. Each party shall bear their costs of this appeal.
