Decision No. 2017-WIL-012(a)

CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS on May 1, 2017, a quota decision made pursuant to the *Wildlife Act* was issued to Raymond Collingwood by David Skerik, Deputy Regional Manager, Skeena Region concerning the 2017/18 quota for bull moose attached to Guide Outfitter Licence GOSM17-270159 for Guiding Territory Certificate 601105 (the "Quota");

AND WHEREAS the Quota for 2017/18 permitted Raymond Collingwood 36 bull moose, of which no more than 1 bull moose may be taken from within M.U. 6-19 Zone A;

AND WHEREAS on May 1, 2017, David Skerik, Deputy Regional Manager, Skeena Region also informed Raymond Collingwood that his allocation for bull moose for the 2017 – 2021 allocation period (April 1, 2017 to March 31, 2021) is 120, of which no more than 4 bull moose may be harvested from M.U. 6-19 Zone A (the "Allocation");

AND WHEREAS Raymond Collingwood has appealed the Quota and the Allocation as they pertain to M.U. 6-19 Zone A;

AND WHEREAS Raymond Collingwood and David Skerik, Deputy Regional Manager, Skeena Region have come to an agreement to resolve the entirety of this appeal by maintaining the Allocation for 2018 – 2021 within M.U. 6-19 Zone A at 4, but revising the annual quota for each year from 2018 – 2021, inclusive, to a maximum of 2 bull moose in M.U. 6-19 Zone A until the relevant Allocation is reached;

NOW THEREFORE the Environmental Appeal Board orders, in full resolution of Raymond Collingwood’s appeal in this matter, and by consent of the Appellant and the Respondent and the Participant, British Columbia Wildlife Federation, that the Allocation is hereby confirmed at 4 for the period ending March 31, 2021, and the annual Quota is hereby set at 2 per hunting year, until the Allocation of 4 has been met;

AND there shall be no costs payable by any party.
