

Appeal: 84/14 WAT

JUDGEMENT

Appeal of Mrs. Sonja O. Townson against an order of the Deputy Comptroller of Water Rights.

Heard at Robson Square Media Centre, Vancouver, B.C. on August 10th, 1984, commencing at 10:00 a.m.

PROCEEDINGS:

Counsel had reached a compromise on the appeal and, therefore, the following order is made by consent.

The Comptroller is directed to amend Conditional Water Licence 59552, issued to Dorothy R. Goddard on 30th April, 1984, as follows:

- (i) Delete paragraph (b) and substitute -
 - (b) The point of diversion shall be from a point

downstream from the existing point of diversion under Conditional Water Licence 59551, as shown on the attached plan.

- (ii) Delete paragraph (h) and substitute -
 - (h) the works authorized to be constructed are diversion structures and pipe to be downstream from the existing point of diversion under Conditional Water Licence 59551, as shown on the attached plan.
- (iii) Amend paragraph (i) by changing the dates, 31st day of October, 1984, and 31st day of December, 1987, to 28th day of February, 1985, and 30th day of June, 1988, respectively.

Any of the parties has liberty to apply to the Board to amend the precise wording to be contained in Conditional Water Licence 59552 if the words set out in this order cause problems to the Comptroller.
